Enrolment Procedures

As of 9th October 2023

The Education Act 1990 governs enrolment in NSW Government Schools.

Compulsory school aged students are entitled to enrol at their local school based on local intake maps. Additionally, parents may apply to enrol their child in a school of their choice. However, acceptance is subject to the school being able to accommodate the child.

Based on 21 permanent classrooms our enrolment cap is **547** students. The school has allocated a buffer of **7** students to accommodate local students enrolling during the year. Therefore, if the numbers are above **540** students, we are unable to enrol non-local students.

We are currently able to enrol non-local students.

Parents can complete both **local** and **non-local** application via the link on the school website.

The transfer of enrolment information between NSW government schools is permitted by parental consent obtained on the enrolment application form. We will seek information from your previous school to support student transition. We will also seek information when a student is enrolling from a non-government school. Please note that **court orders** and other relevant documents need to be provided on enrolment.

Non-local procedures

If demand exceeds positions, the school will form a placement panel and order applications according to:

- Siblings already enrolled at the school.
- Proximity and access to the school
- Safety and supervision of the students before and after school

Appeals
