



**School sporting equipment upgrade** - The P&C have funded a refresh of equipment from the sports store. All students will benefit from this new equipment which is used daily in sports & PE lessons. See our new purchases below! The entire profit from the funds raised at the Easter Raffle this year have covered these costs!









### How are the P&C investing funds raised back into the school?



**IT & STEAM Items** - We are so proud of what we have helped build in the STEAM Hub.

In 2024, the P&C backed the school in establishing our every own dedicated STEAM Hub. This is an incredible resource which kids across the whole school have access to. Last year we purchased **30 brand new laptops**, **a class set of iPads** and **a set of LEGO Spike Kits** (specialised code-able educational building sets).

This year, the P&C will continue to support the development of the school STEAM Hub. We have just funded the purchase of **15 Codrones and a RODE Podcaster Starter Kit**, which all students will have access to during their class times!



The CoDrone EDU is a programmable drone for learning. With its colour sensors, a front range sensor, a bottom range sensor, and more, it's a great way to learn to code. The durable and safe frame, programmable lights, and access to 7 sensors make it an excellent learning tool and a great way to learn coding and engineering skills in the classroom and for competitions.

The Podcast Starter Kit will let the kids create a professional four-person podcast with studio-grade audio.

Capture conversation in rich detail with the PodMics, position them perfectly with the PSA1+ studio arms, monitor voice with the studio-grade NTH-100 headphones, and the RØDECaster Pro II takes care of the rest – mixing, processing, recording and playing sounds and effects.



### How are the P&C investing funds raised back into the school?

**Representative Sporting Shirts** - The P&C continue to support our representative sporting students. We recently purchased 20 new smaller sized shirts for our Zone Athletics Team to make sure that even our youngest athletes have what they need to represent TJPS!



Air Conditioning Installation in the New Hall - The P&C has made a commitment to the school to use money in our building fund towards the installation of air conditioning units in the New Hall. Additional funding towards this will come from the School, as well as from TASK, demonstrating their commitment to our school community.



These ACs will be powered by the newly installed solar system and will greatly benefit our students during those very hot months!

The P&C continues to discuss with the school how we can support our students.
