**P+C Funds - this year our school community raised over \$33,000! for the school** - helping to make it a better place for our children in both the classroom and playground. In addition, donations to the school's Building Fund have let us donate an additional **\$9,000** to make improvements to our new school hall. Following is a rough breakdown of the where the funds are being spent:

- Technology–Computers and Smartboards: \$18,500
- Library books, Lexile Readers, Kindergarten Home Readers, Reading Benchmarking kits, Dictionaries and Thesauruses, Maths Resources: \$8,400
- Projection & sound system and stage curtains for the New Hall, Choir Risers, Wireless Microphone: \$11,600
- Welcome Bushdance, Author visit, Year 6 Cake, School State Representatives, P&C Insurance and incidentals, Science Club, garden club, playground markings: \$2,600

Many thanks to TJPS volunteers and staff who helped to make this all happen - 2011 was certainly a very busy and productive year!

The agenda of the Annual General Meeting shall include setting the membership fee of the Association for the ensuing year.

### Proposal to change by-law 5:

Current 5: A General Meeting of the Association shall be held on the third Wednesday each month during term time at 7:30pm, or as deemed necessary by the executive.

Proposed 5: A General Meeting of the Association shall be held on the **first Tuesday** each month during term time at **7:00pm**, or as deemed necessary by the executive.
