Many parents this year have asked me about the following program. We have been very fortunate to get the Interrelate – Sexuality and Relationships evening program to our school <u>next week</u> on Wednesday evening 16th October. These are excellent programs, interactive, family focused and presented in the context of 'caring relationships'.

Experienced educators will run two sessions of 1 hour – 6.00pm – "Where did I Come From?" for students in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 and at 7.15pm – "Preparing for Puberty" – for students in Years 5 and 6. <u>Students</u> <u>attend the programs accompanied by their parent or</u> <u>parents</u>. It will be up to parents to decide if just one program is suitable for their child – or stay on for both programs – depending on your child's age and developmental maturity.

A separate 'Bright green flyer' was sent home last term with more detailed information on the different programs – to enable you to decide. The costs - \$27.50 per family for one session or \$33.00 per family for 2 sessions are determined by Interrelate Family Centres. More flyers are available in the office foyer.
