NAPLAN

The National Assessment Program for Literacy and Numeracy for Years 3 and 5 students is taking place this week. This diagnostic assessment program is a very useful tool for demonstrating the strengths and areas for development of students. Tuesday will assess Language, Wednesday is Reading and Thursday is the Numeracy Assessment. These assessments give us valuable diagnostic data of students learning and give a snapshot of student achievement at this time of the year.
