PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Charity Day

I was extremely proud of all students last Thursday in their efforts at Charity Day for 2016. It was really interesting to see the COLA area bare at 9.00am, an amazing hive of activity by 11.30am with colourful stalls and goods to sell and tidy and clean again by 1.00pm. It's a credit to all students for their hard work and enthusiasm in making their class stalls as successful as they are and really getting behind the concept of Charity Day – giving to others.

The students raised over \$5,614.95 during those few hours! This is really an amazing achievement. The funds will go towards our annual sponsorship of our World Vision student from Cambodia, Saravut Keo who is 11, as well as a donation to both Cooks Hill Surf Life Saving Club and Merewether Surf Life Saving Club. We hope that the funds will be directed towards supporting children and community members with disabilities to be able to enjoy our wonderful local surf breaks. A representative from both Surf Clubs will be coming to our school to be presented with cheques next Monday 28th November at our morning assembly. We are aware of what a great local community we have with many wonderful volunteers who give so many hours to these clubs for the benefit and safety of our local communities.

Whooping Cough

During the last week we have had reports of whooping cough among our students. This can be a very serious situation especially for young infants and babies. If you think your child might have it, please see your doctor right away. Children under the age of 18 months with whooping cough should be watched at all times, because the coughing spells can make them stop breathing. Young babies with bad cases may need hospital care, too.

At first, whooping cough has the same symptoms as the average cold:

- Mild coughing
- Sneezing
- Runny nose
- Low fever (below 102 F)

You may also have diarrhoea early on in the illness.

After about 7-10 days, the cough turns into "coughing spells" that end with a whooping sound as the person tries to breathe in air.

I have been in contact with Hunter New England Health and they are saying there has been a rise in incidents of this across our region and mostly among already vaccinated children who get a 'mild dose'. Please notify the school if you think your child may have these symptoms. Further information is available from the Hunter New England Health website. Dance Concert Monday 5th December

Please put in your diaries the date of: Monday December 5th at 5.30pm for our celebration of dance at our school. We will be holding a short Dance Concert featuring our Junior Dance, Senior Dance and Ensemble Dance groups as well as our Girl's Tap and Boy's Tap groups and a combined item from both groups. We will also feature some solo items with the evening concluding by 7pm. There will be no charge or tickets – but come along and see how talented your children are in the creative arts area of dancing. All students will receive a certificate. See you then.

Leadership Training 2017

All Year 5 students have participated in Leadership training over the last few weeks as part of our Student Leadership Framework. The students have participated in role play, discuss key leadership attributes... 'what makes a good leader' and were assisted to participate in group discussions on leadership skills. This week students will decide if they wish to stand for any of the student leadership positions or sporting leadership positions to lead the student body in 2017. Students will nominate among their peers who they would like to have stand for the position of school leader. Next Tuesday 29th November at 11.30am, those candidates who have been nominated will write a speech and present it to the student body from Years 2 to 6 as well as staff members. Students will then vote for their school leaders back in class. The results of these elections will be announced at the following Monday morning assembly at 9.00am. Following that announcement we will then elect our Sports Leaders for 2017 and announce the successful students at our lunchtime assembly. This is a very effective personal development program which all Year 5 students really value and enjoy. Parents are welcome to attend the speeches.

An invitation is coming home today to all our parent volunteers who have supported our school all year in any program or activity. This 'Thank you morning tea' will be in





the new school hall at 10.30am next week on Thursday 1st December. Our school is so fortunate to have your support and to benefit from the input of so many wonderful parents and volunteers. We just want the chance to say 'Thank you'. Looking forward to seeing you to say 'thanks'.

Presentation Days 2016

Following is information to parents that our Presentation Days will take place on **Thursday 8th and Friday 9th December** this year. We will start on Thursday 8th December with a whole school assembly from Kinder to Year 6 at 9.00am in the COLA area, present the major awards and prizes as well as invest and present the school captains, prefects, sports house captains and vice captains with their badges. This assembly should take approximately (1) hour. At the following assemblies, in the new school hall, every single child in every class will be called forward to receive a certificate.

At 10.15am on Thursday 8th December in the new school hall we will continue with the Stage 3 assembly (Years 5 and 6) – and present the class awards and some special stage awards.

At 11.00am on Thursday 8th December there will be a morning tea supplied for parents staying on for the next assembly. At 11.30am on Thursday 8th December we will continue with the Stage 2 assembly (Years 3 and 4) and present the class awards and some special stage awards. This assembly should conclude by 1.00pm.

At 9.15am on Friday 9th December in the new school hall we will hold the Early Stage 1 assembly – (Kindergarten) and present the class awards and some special stage awards. At 10.00am (approx) on Friday 9th December we will continue with the Stage 1 assembly (Years 1 and 2) and present the class awards and some special stage awards. This assembly should conclude by 11.15am (approx.)

A morning tea will be available to all attending parents during this time. Presentation Day will be focussed on celebrating the achievements of all students and recognising their efforts over the whole year. There will be some small class items at each assembly.

Swimming Carnival 2017 – Thursday 2nd February

A note will also go home to any Year 1 students (Year 2 - 2017) who will be turning 8 years old in 2017. These students must be able to confidently swim 50m to attend the swimming carnival. Only these Year 2 competitors will travel to the Forum. Otherwise all Year 2 students will stay at school with their class and teacher.

As the carnival is the first week back for students next year, we ask that payment of \$12.00 be paid before the end of this school year.
