# Charity Day - Wonderful Outcome

It is with great pleasure that I inform you that a fantastic outcome of our Charity Day event was that our school was able to donate \$2,500.00 to both Cooks Hill Surf Life Saving Club and Merewether Surf Life Saving Club for their outstanding volunteer work they do within our communities. At last Monday morning's assembly we were fortunate to have representatives from both clubs - Mr Richard Hern and Mr Kris Wall attend, to receive the donations from our school leaders.

Merewether SLSC is using the funding to purchase a rescue board to be used in the surf and also for training purposes. They have been able to have The Junction logo placed on the board as an acknowledgement to the children of our school. Cooks Hill SLSC are using their funds to go towards the purchase of an inflatable wheel chair to provide an opportunity for persons with disabilities to enter and enjoy the water.
