PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Hello to our school community,
Hard to believe we only have two weeks left of the 2017 school year! I look forward to seeing families at our Presentation days on Thursday and Friday of this week.

Presentation Days

A reminder that our Presentation Days will take place this **Thursday 7th and Friday 8th December**. We will start on Thursday 7th December with a 'Whole school assembly' from Kinder to Year 6 at 9.00am in the COLA area. Major awards and prizes will be presented as well as invest and present the 2018 school captains, prefects, sports house captains and vice captains with their badges. This assembly should take approximately (1) hour.

At the following assemblies, in the new school hall, every single child in every class will be called forward to receive a certificate.

At 10.15am on Thursday 7th December in the new school hall we will start with the Stage 3 assembly (Years 5 and 6) – and present the class awards and some special stage awards.

At 11.00am on Thursday 7th December there will be a morning tea supplied for parents staying on for the next assembly.

At 11.30am on Thursday 7th December we will continue with the Stage 2 assembly (Years 3 and 4) and present the class awards and some special stage awards. This assembly should conclude by 1.00pm.

At 9.00am on Friday 8th December in the new school hall we will hold the Early Stage 1 assembly – (Kindergarten) and present the class awards and some special stage awards. **At 10.00am (approx) on Friday 8th December** we will continue with the Stage 1 assembly (Years 1 and 2) and present the class awards and some special Stage awards. This assembly should conclude by 11.15am (approx.)

Presentation Day will be focussed on celebrating the achievements of all students and recognising their efforts over the whole year.

Did you know that Sunday, December the 3rd, was International Day of People with Disability?

This day is celebrated across the world and it aims to increase public awareness, understanding and acceptance of people with disability and celebrate the achievements and contributions of people with disability. The ambassador for this year is Dylan Alcott. Dylan was born with a tumour wrapped around his spinal cord, he survived a three year battle to live and has strived to actively participate in so many aspects of life, to the best of his ability.

He has many great achievements to be proud of including representing Australia at the Para Olympics in both wheelchair basketball and wheelchair tennis from

the age of 13. At the age of 17, Dylan became the youngest ever wheelchair basketball gold medallist. During the Rio Paralympic Games he became one of only a few athletes' to win two gold medals in two different sports.

Dylan is a positive role model for us all at The Junction Public School. He certainly demonstrates our value of participation and is a strong advocate of being inclusive and accepting of people with disabilities.

EXTENDED LEAVE

If your child is going to be absent for over (5) school days you must fill in an Extended Leave Form **before** you go on holidays. The Principal will approve and sign the form and a 'Certificate of Leave' will be returned to the parent. These forms are available from the school office. Thank you.

SMS system for Attendance

Parents must provide an explanation for all absences, **including partial absences**, to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. Where an explanation has not been received within the 7 day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unjustified on the student's record.

To assist with this process, we have introduced an SMS system to notify parents of full day absences. **If you receive a notification please phone, email, use the Skoolbag App or write a note to explain your child's absence.** Please refrain from using Class Dojo messages on the morning of absences as it is not always possible for the class teacher to see this message before the SMS absence alert is sent out at 10am. If you need to update your mobile phone number please see the office staff.
